**ENTRIES:** 

Entry is open to any SQ registered swimmer. All entries must be submitted via online through Swim Central. No monies will be returned for incorrect nominations.

TIMEKEEPERS:

Timekeepers may be required to be provided by each Club. A Club timekeeping roster will be provided.
\*FRIDAY NIGHT: Clubs nominating swimmers in distance events will be required to provide parent timekeepers and lap counters.

AWARDS:

- MEDALS will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place getters for age groups 8yrs, 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs
- Cash Prizes for ages 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 & open (1st - \$10, 2nd - \$5, 3rd - \$3)

Open event cash prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd only

**Major Cash Prize** awarded for 100m Freestyle Male and Female that beat nominated time (Up to \$500 each) Further information below.

**Major Cash Prize** for Mercantile Relay = \$1000 Further information below.

- Open event cash prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd only
- AGE CHAMPION for ages 8, 9, 10, 11, 12,13,14,15,16 & Open
- In the interest of supporting all swimmers we have adjusted the Age Champion points scoring events. Points will be awarded for all events.

- A swimmer must have completed 4 swims to be eligible to become Age Champion.
- An individual's total will be determined from their 5 highest point scoring events.
- In the event of a tie, we will work backwards in points score totals until a winner has been determined.
- Multi Class Age Champion will be determined from the 50m events.
- Multi Class Swimmers are not required to compete in all 4 x 50m events to be eligible for age champion.
- In the event of a tie, the swimmer with the highest aggregate points as calculated by the Swimming Australia.

Class Point Score system, will receive age champion.

Place getters will be determined based on the fastest times recorded using Semi Automatic Timing.

Meet is run in accordance with SL/SQ Rules
