Closing date: 11:59pm on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> October 2023 or earlier if entry limit is reached.

Incomplete or late entries will not be accepted. No monies will be returned for incorrect nominations.

Eligibility: This meet is open to all swimmers registered as competitive swimmers with Swimming Queensland, competitive swimmers registered with clubs affiliated with other state associations and international swimmers who supply a letter of clearance from their national swimming federation.

Age: Age as at day of the meet – 4<sup>th</sup> November 2023

- Spectator Entry:** Spectator tickets will be available upon entry to the facility.  
\$4.00  
Swimmers, coaches, and children under 5 years receive free entry.
- Rules:** The meet will be run in accordance with SAL/SQ Rules. Junior Rule Tolerance will apply only to 7 years and under events.
- Timing:** Semi-automatic timing using the Dolphin Timing system will be used. Clubs will be required to provide timekeepers. A timekeeping roster will be supplied when the program has been finalized.
- Entry Lists:** Entry lists will be emailed to clubs after nominations have closed. Please notify the club of any discrepancies by 5pm Monday 30<sup>th</sup> October 2023.
- Programs:** The meet program and draft timeline will be emailed to clubs and appear on our website and Swim Central by Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2023. No programs will be available for sale on the day of the meet.
- Photos:** In nominating for this meet, swimmers agree that they may be photographed by Club approved photographers, and images may be used by the club on their website and social media pages as well as in print media.

### Refund Policy:

No refunds will be given for withdrawal from the meet unless due to medical reasons. Notification must be given to our Race Secretary by Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> November 2023, along with a refund request via Swim Central and a medical certificate to be provided within 7 days of the meet.

No refunds will be given if the meet is cancelled on the day due to adverse weather conditions.

### Awards:

Medals will be awarded for the first 3 placegetters in each individual age event - 50m and 100m events, and 200m events – from 8 years to 17 years & over, and each Multi Class event.

Medals will not be awarded for 7 years & under events; however, all 7 years & under competitors will receive a participation award on the day.

Age Champion awards, male and female, will be presented to each age group from 8 years to 17 years & over. The swimmer with the highest number of points at the completion of the session will be awarded Age Champion. Points are awarded as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> 6 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> 3 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> 1 point.

Multi Class Champion awards, male and female, will be awarded, based on results from the Multi Class events, in both the Junior and Senior sessions. The award will be presented to the swimmer with the highest number of points using the above point scoring system.

Awards will be handed out through the meet. Please collect them before the end of the session.

### Food:

No BBQ will be available on the day. The Aquatic Centre Café will be operating during the day.

### Water:

To do our part to save the environment we ask that you bring a waterbottle and refill it from one of the water stations around the pool.

### Tents:

**Please note that no tent pegs are allowed in the grounds of the Aquatic Centre. Please bring your own sandbags and tents.**
