


HERVEY BAY 2024 LONG COURSE PREPARATION MEET

TIME:

Friday 26th January 2024 – Gates open at 3:30pm

Warm-up starts at 4:00pm until 4:45pm for a 5:00pm start

Saturday 27th January 2024 – Gates open at 7:00am

Warm-up starts at 7:30am until 8:15am for an 8:30am start

ENTRY AND MEET PROGRAM:

Swimmers and coaches are free entry

Spectator tickets available for purchase on Swim Central for \$5.00 per

person (entry valid both days). Under 7 years free entry.

Programs for this event will be emailed to all clubs prior to the meet. Please obtain a personal copy of this program as there will be no copies

available at the gate.

NOMINATION FEE:

\$7.50 Nomination fees will apply to each event for 8 years & over plus any

online fees.

\$4.50 Nomination fee will apply to each 25m event for 7 years & under plus

any online fees.

No refunds will be given for withdrawal from this meet unless for a medical reason. Please provide a medical certificate if withdrawing from any events by no later than 8:00am on 26th January 2024. No refunds will be given if

the meet is cancelled due to a weather event.

NO LATE NOMINATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED

AGE DETERMINATION:

Age as at 27th January 2024

Athletes cannot swim up an age in individual events.

- Minimum age to compete at this event is 5 years & over
- Maximum age for 25m events is 7 years
- Minimum age for 50m events, 100 freestyle, 200 freestyle and 200 individual medley is 8 years & over
- Minimum age for 800m freestyle, 200m butterfly, 200m backstroke and 200m breaststroke is 11 years & over
- Minimum age for 400m freestyle is 10 years & over
- Minimum age for 100m backstroke, 100m breaststroke and 100m butterfly is 9 years & over

ELIGIBILITY:

This meet is open to Swimming Australia affiliated competitive swimmers.

MULTI-CLASS EVENTS:

Multi class swimmers must be registered as 'competitive' swimmers with a Swimming Australia club. Your classification number must be registered against your swimmers record in Swim Central.

Medals/points will be awarded for 1st, 2nd & 3rd place using the Swimming Australia Multi Class point score.

Age Champion will be awarded using the swimming Australia Multi Class point score.

EVENTS:

As per program of events below.

Please be advised that all events will be timed finals. The Meet Director reserves the right to cancel, combine and alter any event if required.

ENTRY LIST:

Parents/caregivers and Race Secretary need to check the entry list when they are sent out to clubs and respond to the Race Secretary with any questions within 2 days of the entry list being made available.

RULES:

This meet will be run in accordance with the SAL/SQ rules.

TIMEKEEPERS/OFFICIALS:

Timekeepers will be provided by clubs. The timekeeping schedule will be determined by the number of swimmers per club attending.

Swimmers that are swimming in the 800m freestyle event will be required to provide lap counters and timekeepers for this event to ensure that the event runs smooth.

TENT PLAN:

Each club will have an allocated tent area allocated for swimmers and spectators.

MEDALS AND AWARDS:

Swimmers aged 7 years & under: Participation ribbons will be awarded to all swimmers in this age group. No age champion will be awarded in this age group.

Swimmers aged 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 & over: Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place getters for all individual age groups within each event.

Multi class swimmers: Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place getters for each event under the multi class point score. Age champion will be awarded to the highest points scored in the 50m events only using the Swimming Australia multi class point score.

Pool records: Certificates will be awarded to any swimmer that breaks an existing record at this event.

AGE CHAMPIONS:

Age champion will be awarded as follows:

- 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 & over 4 x 50m Events and 200m IM. All five events must be swum to be eligible. Points will be awarded as follows: 1st 6 points, 2nd 3 points, and 3rd 1 point.
- Multi class swimmers will not be required to swim in all the 50m events to be eligible but will be determined by the highest aggregate points score from the 50m events as per the Swimming Australia multi class point score.
