Nominations:	7 years & under - \$4.00 per event plus online processing fees 8 years & over - \$8.00 per event plus online processing fees All entries must be submitted via Swim Central online. <u>https://swimcentral.swimming.org.au</u> Incomplete or late entries will not be accepted. No monies will be returned for incorrect nominations.
Eligibility:	Entry is open to all swimmers registered as competitive swimmers with Swimming Queensland
Age:	Age as at day of the meet – 20 th January 2024.
Rules:	Meet is run in accordance with SAL/SQ Rules. Junior Tolerance Rules will apply to 7 years and under events.
Timing:	Semi-automatic timing using the Dolphin Timing System will be used. Clubs will be required to provide timekeepers. A timekeeping roster will be supplied when the program has been finalised.
Programs:	Entry lists will be emailed out to clubs for checking. Please notify the club of any discrepancies by 5pm Sunday 14 th January 2024. The Meet Program will be emailed out by Thursday 18 th January 2024. Results will be available on Meet Mobile.

Photos:	In nominating for this meet, swimmers agree that they may be photographed by Club approved photographers, and images may be used by the Club on their social media pages as well as print in media.	
COVID Safe Meet Information:	All visitors to the Meet, including Swimmers, will be required to follow current Queensland Health restrictions.	
Awards:	Medals will be awarded to the first 3 placegetters in each individual age event – 50m and 100m events, and 200m events – from 8 years to 17 years & over, and each Multi Class event with Boys & Girls combined.	
	Medals will not be awarded for 7 years & under events, however all 7 year and under competitors will receive a participation award on the day.	
	Age Champion Awards, male and female, will be presented to each age group from 8 years to 18 years & over. The swimmer with the highest number of points at the completion of the session will be awarded Age Champion. Points are awarded as follows: $1^{st} - 6$ points, $2^{nd} - 3$ points, $3^{rd} - 1$ point. In the event that there is a tie for Age Champion, both winners will be presented with the Age Champion Award.	
	Multi Class Champion awards, male and female, will be awarded as a combined result based on Multi Class events swum throughout the day. The award will be presented to the swimmer with the highest number of points using the above points system.	
	Awards will be handed out throughout the meet. Please collect these after announcements have been made at the Medals Tent.	
Food:	There will be a food van supplying bacon & egg burgers, hamburgers and chips – Rotary Kingaroy. A coffee van will be onsite – MJ's Coffee. Summer Country Aquatics Pool Canteen supplying cold drinks, Iollies, ice-creams, pies, sausage rolls and packet chips.	
Water:	Water will be available to purchase from Summer Country Aquatics Pool Canteen. Water stations will also be available to re-fill your water bottles.	
Tents:	Tent pegs are allowed on the grounds of Kingaroy Aquatic Centre. Please bring your own tents.	
Refund Policy:	No refunds will be given for withdrawal from the meet unless due to medical reasons. Notification must be given to our Race Secretary by 5pm Wednesday 17 th January 2024, along with a refund request and medical certificate. No refunds will be given if the Meet is cancelled on the day due to inclement weather.
