CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1) All competitors must be registered with QSA at time of nomination.
- 2) The carnival will be conducted under QSA rules.
- 3) All entries to be submitted via online nomination process SwimCentral. No late entries accepted. **NOMINATIONS CLOSE Wednesday 14th August 2024**
- 4) Entry times are automatically collated from SwimCentral and will not be changed.
- 5) Submit Coach times for assistance in preparation of timeline.
- 6) Age group for swimmers will be calculated as at the day of the meet.
- No refunds will be given for non-attendance (unless a medical certificate is provided by Thursday 14th August 12pm) or weather events.
- 8) Individual medley races consist of equal distances of butterfly, backstroke, breaststroke and freestyle in that order.
- 9) Swimmers must swim in lanes allotted by self-marshalling details on the entry list.
- 10)Events/ heats may be combined at the discretion of the Marshall/ Referee. Heats may not be reseeded.
- 11)Placing will be decided on the fastest times in heats of all events. There will be no finals. Ribbons will be presented for 1st, 2nd & 3rd best times.
- 12)All events are open to multi-class swimmers.
- 13)Multi-class swimmers will be placed into heats according to seed time.
- 14)Multi-class swimmers will be presented ribbons for 1st, 2nd & 3rd best times in each event separate to non Multi-class swimmers.
- 15) Multi-class entries should clearly state swimmer's classification code.
- 16) The one-start rule will apply throughout.
- 17) Feet first entry for all backstroke events.
- 18)"Over the Top" starting will apply at the discretion of the Referee.
- 19) The Team Representative must submit protests to the Referee in writing, together with a deposit of \$50.00 and within 30 minutes of the posting of results. Deposit only refunded if protest upheld.
- 20)Clubs will provide timekeepers as per roster in the meet program.
- 21)In nominating for this Meet, Swimmers agree that they may be photographed by Club approved photographers and images may be used by the club on their website and social media pages.
