Each Multi Class swimmer on a team earns a time reduction, based on average differences between Multi Class and able bodied swimmers of the same age in the Wide Bay region.

Meet Information

- Date: Sunday, November 2, 2025
- Venue: Flinders Phoenix Swim Club, 1-47 Stringybark Road, Buderim, Old 4556
- **Pool Type:** Short Course Pool (25m)
- Opening Times: The Flinders Phoenix Aquatic Centre will open at 9:30 AM
- Warm-up: Warm-up will commence at 9:45 AM and cleared 15 minutes prior to race start
- **Eligibility:** Swimmers must be registered members of a club affiliated with Swimming Wide Bay
- **Photography & Filming:** Photography and filming will be conducted in line with the National Integrity Framework and Swimming Australia's child safety policies. By entering this event, you consent to swimmers being photographed and videoed by the event photographer. These images may be used for promotional purposes by Swimming Wide Bay
- Age: Age as of November 2, 2025.

Club and Mixed Relay Team Entry and Payments

- Club Relay Teams: Entries are \$10 per relay team and are to be completed through Swim Central
- Mixed Club Teams: We know not every club can always fill a whole relay team, and
 that shouldn't stop swimmers from joining the fun! If you'd like to take part but
 don't have a complete team, let us know. We'll help connect clubs and swimmers
 and form mixed Swimming Wide Bay teams so everyone has the chance to get
 involved and race. Entries are \$2.50 per swimmer/club in each relay team. Simply

- Entry Dates: Event closes Monday, October 20, 2025
- Entry List & Changes: The entry list will be emailed to clubs and available on the event page on Wednesday, October 22. Any changes must be submitted via an online form by 12 PM, Friday, October 24
- Withdrawals: Withdrawals are only eligible for a refund in the case of a medical reason. No refunds will be issued if the meet is cancelled due to adverse incident or weather
- **Spectator Fees**: There are no spectator fees. To help us manage space and ensure everyone's comfort, we kindly ask that only one parent or caregiver per swimmer.

Relay Restrictions

- Clubs are restricted to a maximum of three (3) teams in each event
- A swimmer may compete in a maximum of three (3) age group relay teams
- Mixed relays must comprise of two (2) females and two (2) males in the team
- Multi Class swimmers: Time reductions will be applied for teams with Multi Class swimmers. If a team has more than one, the reductions will be added together and then taken off the team's achieved time.





Time Reductions

Classification	Time Reductions
S5	60 sec
S6	10 sec
S7	8.5 sec
S8	5.5 sec
S9	4 sec
S10	3.5 sec
S14	3.5 sec
S19	3.5 sec

- Times have been calculated from Wide Bay
- Multi Class Swimmers, average time differences away from Wide Bay able bodied Swimmers (AGE SPECIFIC)
- The above times will be deducted from the final relay time
- If more than one MC swimmer (S19 and S8) the two time reductions will be added together and then taken off their times.

Please remember this is a first of its kind and is a trial. The time adjustments have been calculated with the help of the Multi Class Swimming Wide Bay support team.

Premiership Points

Points will be awarded in all divisions based on the following scale

1st place: 10 points
2nd place: 8 points
3rd place: 6 points
4th place: 5 points
5th place: 4 points
6th place: 3 points
7th place: 2 points
8th place: 1 point

Awards

- SWB Relay Champion Trophy: Awarded to the club with the highest points
- **SWB Lane Warriors Champion:** Awarded to the winning Mercantile Relay team based on their proximity to their nominated time
- SWB Best Team Spirit: Recognizes the club with the most energy, enthusiasm, support for the whole swimming community and unique cheer and/or presentation.

Mercantile Relay - ALL

- **Format:** 8 x 50M
- Team Size: Each team must consist of eight swimmers
 - Placings are based on the team with the closest time to their nominated time
- Stroke Requirement:
 - The starting stroke must be backstroke
 - Three (3) swimmers must swim at least one of the form strokes (Backstroke, Breaststroke, or Butterfly)
 - The other seven swimmers have a choice
 - The order of strokes after the start, can be decided by the team.

Logistics and Procedures

- Parking & Drop-off: View parking layout on Page 7.
- **Pool Deck Access:** Only coaches, technical officials, swimmers, MC helpers, and volunteers are permitted on the pool deck. Access bands will be issued
- Food and Drinks: Catering will be available
- **Bags and Eskies:** Must be no bigger than 40cm x 40cm x 40cm, soft to the touch, and stored within the swimmer's space. All other bags/eskies will be refused
- **Rosters:** Timekeeper and volunteer rosters will be published on the website closer to the Championships
- **Timeline:** The timeline will be published on the website by Thursday, October 30, 2025. It is a guide only and actual start times may vary
- **Program:** An online program will be published on the website and Swim Central on Wednesday, October 29, 2025. No printed programs will be available
- Marshalling Procedures: Guided marshalling will be in place. All four swimmers in each team must report to the marshalling area together at least two events prior to the start of their race.. This also applies to the 10 swimmers of the mercantile relays. Failure to do so may result in a withdrawal of the team
- **Results:** Results will be viewable on Meet Mobile. A PDF results file will be published on the website after the championships. TM Results files will only be provided upon request to club race secretaries
- Other Procedures:
 - The Swimming Wide Bay Code of Conduct will be enforced
 - Protests must be submitted in writing to the Referee by a Team Manager or Coach with a \$100 deposit within 30 minutes of the event's conclusion
 - The Championships will be conducted under the rules of World Aquatics, Swimming Australia, and Swimming Queensland, with any additions or amendments by Swimming Wide Bay.
